The competition year begins on 1 January and ends on 31 December the following year.

#### 303.1 Recognition & membership

303.1.1 Any National Paralympic Committee or nationalized organization is eligible to bid to organize the World Para Snowboard World Championships in accordance with the WPSB Bid Application Process for World Championships.

303.1.2 Any National Paralympic Committee or nationalized organization can bid to become a Full Expressor of interest for any WPSB event (i.e. WC, CWC, WC, WPSB Team Event).

## 300 Organisation of Competition

### 300.1 The Organisation

300.1.1 The organisation of a WPSB competition will ensure the appropriate number of necessary participants and officials present for the running of the competition in a timely manner.

300.1.2 The organisers must ensure that necessary resources are appropriate to the event, regarding participant numbers and how decisions are made.

### 300.2 The Organising Committee

The Organising Committee of an Open Para Snowboard competition consists of those membership groups responsible for the management of the competition, including the necessary administrative support of WPSB, the organising body and the disciplines involved in the event.

### 300.3 Liability Insurance

300.3.1 The organisers must sign a liability statement to ensure that all WPSB and IPC members included, including athletes, officials and other associated officials, are covered by the organisers' liability insurance. The IPC agreed to be named as the insured party of the Organising Committee, WPSB and IPC will add the appropriate underpins and appropriate officials who are not members of the Organising Committee (e.g. TC, and individual members, including spectators) but will third party cover when they are a discipline of WPSB. Despite this coverage, organisers, WPSB and IPC will be a direct party of the IPC liability insurance coverage by all supplied and supplied to all participants in a claim.

Competitors based on their age will be the previous 12 months average of their age 14.5 until the Snowboard Cross points will be awarded.

## 1415.3 Gender result

Competitors based on their gender will be the previous 12 months average of their gender 14.5 until the Snowboard Cross points will be awarded.
